



The criteria for selection

- Single, unmarried men between ages 19 to 28
- No dependents; as the student will be away from home and not earning an income puts the family at financial risk
- Matric certificate/ current CV/ motivation letter written by applicant himself
- No criminal record
- Fair/good English literacy and numeracy
- Prepared to live away from home for 12 months
- Good mental and physical health
- Good attitude
- Serious about learning traditional tracking skills

Important facts to know:

- The bus tickets to and from the Tracker Academy are for your own account.
- Telephone calls and personal items such as 'toiletries' are for your own account
- All training, accommodation, food, learner materials and uniform will be sponsored.
- There is only cell phone signal next to the school in the bush. Phone calls can be received at lunchtime at the Academy on 087 550 1536
- A once-a-month town trip is provided for you to buy your personal items. Each student will require approximately R150 per month for personal items. The amount of money you bring is entirely up to you.
- Please notify us if you have ANY medical conditions – mental or physical
- You will be living in remote isolated areas.
- You will be told about the Tracker Academy **"Code of Conduct"** – Discipline is important at the Academy
- The Tracker Academy reserves the right to remove any student with immediate effect should they be in breach of the code of conduct.
